



TIN Arts are a dance company based in Durham City working across the North East of England.



TIN Arts work with people of all ages and abilities. A lot of the activities we deliver include dancers with a learning disability, autism or both.



Some projects are focused on working with dancers who display talent or a strong ability in dance.

The **EMERGING YOUNG DANCERS** programme is for young people aged 11 – 18 years old with a learning disability or autism who love to dance, would like to do more and are considered to be talented.



TIN Arts are looking for new dancers from across the North East of England to join the programme.



The programme will start in January 2018 and will involve taking part in regular dance classes with staff from TIN Arts.

Those who join the programme will work other dancers of a similar age to create new pieces of dance which will be performed in theatres across the North East of England in 2018.





The programme is free to join and TIN Arts are able to help with some travel and access costs.



Some of these dance classes may take place in school time and some of them will take place out of school time.



Where the classes take place will depend on where the young people live.

TIN Arts are holding open workshops across the North East for anyone interested in finding out more.
