The programme, led by TIN Arts, will offer regular dance classes and workshops to each young dancer chosen to help develop their potential and talent.

What is involved

First of all join in with one of the many 'taster' dance workshops happening across the North East in **November 2017** when you can meet TIN Arts staff and find out more. From the workshops TIN Arts will invite up to twelve young people to join the programme as a member from **January 2018**.

All members will meet regularly to create a new piece of dance from **January – February** using a range of locations across the North East.

Then from **March – July 2018** the Emerging Young Dancers will perform at venues and events across the North East.

Joining the programme is **FREE** with some funding available to meet costs related to access, support and travel.
